by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 47, Chapter 18, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

- (a) A person selling or offering for sale goods or services at retail shall not require a buyer to pay using credit, or prohibit cash as payment, in order to purchase the goods or services. A person selling or offering for sale goods or services at retail shall accept legal tender when offered by the buyer as payment.
 - (b) Subsection (a) only applies to:
 - (1) A person that employs at least six (6) employees; and
 - (2) Transactions occurring in-person.

(c)

- (1) Subsection (a) does not apply to a retailer that provides a device on the premises of the retailer that converts cash, without charging a fee or requiring a minimum deposit amount greater than five dollars (\$5.00), into a prepaid card that allows a buyer to complete a transaction at such retail establishment.
- (2) Subsection (a) does not apply to a public institution of higher education that provides a location, during regular business hours, on campus that converts cash, without charging a fee or requiring a minimum deposit amount greater than five dollars (\$5.00), into a prepaid card that allows a buyer to complete a transaction at such campus.

- (3) Upon request by a buyer, the device described in subdivisions (c)(1) and (2) must provide each consumer with a paper or electronic receipt indicating the amount of cash the buyer deposited onto the prepaid card
- (4) Cash deposits onto such a prepaid card are not subject to an expiration date, and there is no limit on the number of transactions that may be completed on such prepaid card.
- (5) Subsection (a) does not apply to special events or parking transactions on the campus of a public institution of higher education.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2025, the public welfare requiring it.
