

# 2026 South Dakota Cash Bills

## HB 1061

- Requires acceptance of cash for in-person retail transactions less than \$100.
- Cash only needs to be accepted at one point-of-sale.
- Also requires state agencies to accept cash. Excludes security/damage deposits, rental car & airplane transactions, and banks.
- Cannot charge more for cash than for other payments sources.

## Why HB 1061

- Ensures that the 19% of adults without a credit card can still buy food [2024 federal reserve statistic].
- Makes South Dakota resilient in case of disasters like tornadoes, floods, fires, and software hacker attacks.
- Means more money will go to South Dakota businesses instead of out-of-state.
- Preserves privacy and financial transaction freedom.

## HCR 6004

- Encourages the use of physical cash for transactions.
- Encourages businesses to offer a discount for using physical cash in transactions.
- Encourages citizens to support businesses that offer a cash discount.

- Brings attention to businesses that offer a cash discount.
- Brings awareness to the use of cash to protect freedom.
- Makes South Dakota resilient in case of disasters like tornadoes, floods, fires, and software hacker attacks.
